HUNTINGTOWN HIGH SCHOOL PARKING RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Students who are issued parking permits must park their vehicle in an appropriate space within the student parking lot. The hang tag must be visible in the front windshield of your vehicle.
- Student drivers who do not have a first period class and their last class of the day ends before eight period may park in the front of the school, if no other parking spaces are available. Do not park in the area directly in front of the cafeteria. A special hang tag will be issued to these students.
- 3. Upon arrival at school, student drivers must immediately exit their parked vehicle and may not loiter in or around their vehicle or any other vehicle. The same rule applies when a student driver is dismissed at the end of their school day.
- 4. No loud music is allowed while on school property.
- 5. Once students have parked, they may not return to their vehicles during the school day, including lunch, without a pass from a school administrator. No teacher may grant such permission to a student and students returning to their vehicle without proper authority will have their parking permit suspended or revoked.
- 6. The student and his/her parent/guardian acknowledge that they are aware that the Calvert County Public Schools, the Board of Education, and Huntingtown High School do not assume any responsibility for damage or theft involving vehicles parked under this agreement. To that end, students are encouraged not to leave any valuables in their vehicles and to remove their keys and lock their vehicles after parking them.
- 7. The student acknowledges that he/she will be held personally responsible for any contraband discovered within his/her automobile, regardless of ownership of the vehicle. To that end, student drivers will insure that no weapons of any type, alcohol, tobacco products or controlled dangerous substances are stored in any vehicle they park on school property.
- 8. The school administration has the right to search any student vehicle parked on school property. Vehicles in the school's parking lot will be randomly searched throughout the school year.
- 9. No student will be issued a parking permit until ALL his/her financial obligations are satisfied.
- 10. By entering this agreement, the student and the parent/guardian acknowledge that they understand and that the student agrees to comply with all provisions of this agreement. The student and his/her parent/guardian acknowledge that any violation of this agreement will result in the suspension of the student's parking privilege in addition to any sanctions imposed under the Student Code of Conduct. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF MONIES, SHOULD PARKING PRIVILEGES BE REVOKED.**

NO PARKING PERMITS WILL BE ISSUED TO SOPHOMORES OR FRESHMEN.
